Introduction

With international cooperation in architectural projects becoming increasingly frequent, stakeholders from different countries may encounter difficulties to find a common understanding when it comes to the various phases of a project. This can result in confusion when jointly defining the order, the content, the billing and the legal considerations for every project milestone.

As of June 2020, we are not aware of any official documentation that contextualizes Spanish practices within an international framework. We support the idea that an architectural project should rely on the local, regional or national processes of its geographic location in order to ensure legal compliance. However, we feel compelled to benchmark Spanish practices in order to gain transparency and efficiency with our international partners.

The present document aims to be a first effort to bring our practices and processes closer to our colleagues from around the world. We are looking forward to your comments and suggestions and hope to keep this document alive with your contribution.
